2. If you make a decision to take a risk on Jesus and it is harder than you expected, do you question your decision? Why or why not? Why do Christians tend to think that God is only in the good things, but not the bad?

3. What is the spiritual condition of a person apart from Jesus? What is blocking them from believing in Jesus? How do Ephesians 2:1-2, 2 Corinthians 4:4, and 1 Corinthians 2:14 answer this question?

4. Do you believe it is necessary for people who don't know Jesus to hear from a missionary about him in order that they may believe or does God save people apart from someone preaching the Gospel message? What is the eternal destiny of those who never hear the Gospel? If they can be saved apart from the preaching of the Gospel, why did Paul and Barnabas go out to proclaim to them?

5. What is the most amazing story of someone coming to faith in Christ that you know of? Why is it amazing? Who was instrumental in your coming to faith in Christ? Why?
