3. How aware of the immaterial world should we be in order to be a healthy Christian? What does it look like if people focus too much on demons and angels? What does it look like when people focus too little on demons and angels?

4. How influential in your life is the knowledge that Jesus has already won the victory over the principalities and powers? How should that knowledge affect how you live here and now?

5. Are there any other parts of 1 Peter 3:18-22 that stuck out to you and have had you thinking over the last days? Share your questions and thoughts with the group.
