1. What is something that you have been reluctant to do in your life? what got you to finally do that thing?

2. Read Jeremiah 1:1-19 What stands out to you the most as you read through it?

3. What was the moral and spiritual climate like in Israel before Jeremiah began his ministry in the days of King Josiah? See 2 Kings 21. How is this comparable to our day?

4. We saw that God had a plan for Jeremiah's life. What do you think God's plan for your life is? do you know what he has called you to do? Are you doing it?

5. How does the provision of God's presence change your attitude about stepping into serving the Lord?

6. Have you been resistant to do what God has called you to do? If God's expectation is obedience for the things he calls us to do, what are you going to do before you leave today to make sure you are meeting that expectation?

7. Ministry is hard sometimes – it certainly was for Jeremiah – how can you encourage each other this week? ref. Difficult ministry in Jeremiah 4:19; 5:13-14; 6:11, 27-29; 8:18-9:3, 10; 10:19-20; 11:14, 18, 21
